Budget Vote

Nadia R. presents the CSS budget vote, highlighting some changes in the services fee there's a decrease with the athletics and reaction fee of \$6. This is due to increased enrolment, increased collaboration and resource sharing. The decrease in student fees doesn't mean cutting back or downscaling in any way. Programming has adapted hybrid models and will continue to increase student services online presence.

our planning, significant reorganizers for student services. A lot has been done in the last decade and there's a lot more to do, there is an exciting future ahead.
