



## Application for the C. K. Govind Excellence Award

**Award History:** The C. K. Govind Excellence Award was established in 2003. This award honours the memory of Dr. C. K. Govind for his outstanding contribution to undergraduate teaching during his 30 year tenure in the Department of Life Sciences at the University of Toronto Scarborough. Professor Choonilal Keshav (C. K.) Govind (1938 to 2002) was a faculty member at University of Toronto Scarborough and gained an international reputation based on his research on the structure and function of the neuromuscular system in crustaceans. He was a popular teacher and was the recipient of the 1988 Teaching Award at University of Toronto Scarborough.

**Criteria:** The scholarship will be awarded to a full-time undergraduate student entering the fourth year of study in the programs of Integrative Biology or Neuroscience. In addition to academic excellence (minimum cumulative GPA 3.3/B plus is required), candidates must demonstrate a commitment to enhancing the lives of other people, by his/her volunteer work within the community. Candidates must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents.
