Two spies, A and B, are captured.

They are interrogated separately. If either prisoner betrays the other, the betrayer will be freed and the other tortured and then executed.

If they both remain silent, they are both imprisoned for six months.

If they each betray the other, they will be executed (but not tortured).

Putting yourself in A's place, what should you do?
