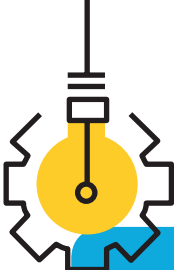

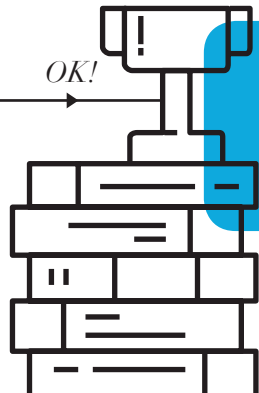
Are you sure? Some programs/schools look at grades in the final 1-2 years of study/last 5-10 credits.
