#### **Ann Boddington Prize in Music Performance**

To be awarded to a student entering 3rd or 4th year in any program, that has made contribution to music performance at UTSC, is active in the campus community, and is in good academic standing. A student can win this award only once.

#### **Leigha Lee Browne Scholarship in Drama**

To be awarded to a student displaying outstanding ability in the dramatic arts, who is either continuing in a drama program at UTSC or is graduating and has registered in an advanced training program in the dramatic arts.

*The following awards are given automatically to the best qualifying student – they do not require an application:*

#### **Arts Management Scholarship**

To be awarded to a student in the co-op Arts Management program who is in good academic standing, and based on Financial Need.

#### **Yvonne C. M. Chiu Memorial Scholarship in Arts Management**

To be awarded to a student entering 3rd or 4th year who is registered in the Arts Management Co-op Specialist program on the basis of excellent academic achievement and a minimum CGPA of 3.3. On the basis of achievement in a recent work placement.

#### **Krashinsky Visual & Performing Arts**

To be awarded to a student enrolled in Visual & Performing Arts who has completed at least 10 full credits and has achieved excellent standing in VPA courses.

#### **Leverington, Lawrence B. Mentor Award**

To be awarded to a student entering 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year, with outstanding musical ability in 1 of 3 areas: direction, composition, or performance. The student must be in good academic standing and demonstrate financial need
