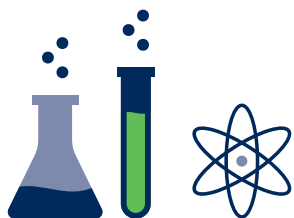

it's because of the shimmer, the verge, and the yet. is the largest solo exhibition of works by Erika DeFreitas to date, spanning a timeline of almost two decades. This homecoming show by the Scarborough artist and UTSC alum addresses historical and archival absences, centring those who have been marginalized, misrepresented, and erased.
