CERA Working group or Travel Fund Application Deadline: Sep. 30th, 2023 Value and duration: see below

Details:

- 1. Applicant must be a faculty member, graduate student or postdoc at UTSC.
- 2. Applicants can request funds to support either a scholarly meeting/working group (up to \$15,000, faculty must be the applicant) or travel to present work (up to \$2,500).
- Applicants requesting travel must be attending and presenting at a conference (talk or poster) or participating in a training workshop at least 80 km away from Toronto. This can cover travel between June 1, 2023 – Aug 31, 2024.
- 4. Applicants requesting working group support need to justify the topic and should include several UTSC members in the meeting, with clear benefits to UTSC members.
- 5. Eligible costs include: travel expenses (airline or train ticket), hotel/hostel, conference registration fees, etc.
- 6. This is not a reimbursement, supervisors must ensure student travel is covered with these funds.
