Details:

1. Applicant must hold a tenure stream faculty position at UTSC.
2. Applicants can request up to \$5,000 per year for research support.
3. Eligible costs include: consumables, experimental apparatus (e.g., test tubes, watering cans, etc.), undergraduate research assistance (e.g., to extend work-study periods), research-related travel and dissemination costs (i.e., open access fees).
4. Applications supporting a trainee’s research must still be submitted by the faculty supervisor.
