### NEW LABORATORY DOOR SIGNAGE

To enhance campus communications and emergency preparedness, Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) will be working with academic departments, Principal Investigators and Lab Managers to implement the new laboratory door signage at the University of Toronto Scarborough (UTSC).

The new signage will incorporate the following key information into one concise document:

1. Legislated permits (e.g. Biosafety, Radiation, etc.)
2. Key hazards
3. Safety precautions (e.g. Personal protective equipment, general & specific safety instructions)
4. Contact information (e.g. Key lab contacts and emergency numbers)
