



UTSC Graduate Student Research Award Application Form - 2023

The purpose of the UTSC Graduate Student Research Award is to recognize the research activities of graduate students as well as their overall contribution to the University of Toronto Scarborough by offering two awards annually, one for a master's student, valued at \$2,000 and one for a doctoral student, valued at \$3,000.

The eligibility criteria are as follows:

1. Research stream Master's and PhD students currently enrolled full-time in the School of Graduate Studies
2. [UTSC-affiliated on ACORN](#)
3. Supervised (or co-supervised) by U of T Scarborough-based faculty

For the Doctoral Award, preference will be given to mid-to-senior graduate students currently enrolled in their program who do not plan to defend before the end of the 2023 summer term.

Application Process:

The award application consists of the following two components that must be submitted separately to graduate-awards@utsc.utoronto.ca by **Monday, April 17, 2023**:

1. **Student component** - Applicant's CV and completed application form (below) submitted by the applicant, using the following naming convention:
 - CV: *LastName_CV_GRSA2023*
 - Application form: *LastName_Form_GSRA2023*
2. **Faculty component** - Signed reference letter on departmental letterhead submitted directly by a U of T Scarborough faculty member familiar with the applicant's work, mentioning the extent of the graduate student's involvement in the generation of their research contributions (e.g. conceptualization of research design, execution of research, data collection, interpretation of data, etc.). With the following naming convention: *ApplicantLastName_Reference_GRSA2023*

Applicants will receive confirmation that the reference letter has been submitted and their application is complete.
