

University of Toronto Scarborough Admission Requirements – Regular Chinese High School System

- For students currently under regular Chinese high school system and will receive a High School Diploma issued by the Chinese Education Authority, your admissions is based on the following academic documents, for the required documents, please refer to the document checklist:
 - o Senior 1 and 2 official transcripts
 - Official Senior 3 course list
 - For Student who has enrolled in multiple schools only: Complete School History and Letter of Explanation for original student residency 借读证明 (if applicable)
 - Non Beijing Hukou Explanation (if applicable)
 - School Profile, for students studying in non partner schools
- For students currently studying a dual curriculum (such as Sino US, Sino UK, etc.), you must
 indicate the curriculums / additional tests you are taking. Your admissions will be reviewed on an
 individual basis. If you fail to disclose your full academic record at the time of admissions, we might
 withdraw your application.
- For students who have graduated from high school, you must submit the following documents with your application:
 - All 3-year official high school transcripts in Chinese and English with official school stamp
 - Official University / College transcripts if you have attended any post-secondary institutions
 - High school diploma and GaoKao results verified by the <u>CSSD China Credentials</u> <u>Verification</u>
 - If you are not attending any post- secondary institution at the time of the Green Path Application, please submit a signed & dated letter explaining your plans during this time along with your application.
