

University of Toronto Scarborough Admission Requirements – Non-Chinese / International School System

Please note: this page is for information purpose only. Green Path program is not open to students under Canadian curriculum system, you need to apply directly on [Ontario Universities' Application Centre](#). Applicants from the GCE or IB systems must ensure they can arrive on the May start date for the Green Path program in order to be eligible to apply.

For students under a Non-Chinese / International School System (i.e. IB, GCE/A-Level etc.) and will receive a high school diploma issued by non-Chinese Education Authorities, you need to submit the documents listed below:

1) General Certificate of Education (GCE) System

- a) You may be considered **only** if you already have at least four final results in required Advanced Subsidiary (AS) examinations. A minimum grade of C in each subject is required for consideration (higher grades are needed for competitive programs like Management and Co-op Programs).
- b) Please indicate on your application that you are in the GCE System. Provide the name of the British Examination Board(s) for which your school is offering the subjects – examples: University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) / Pearson Edexcel (EDEXCEL), indicate the highest level you will be completing (AS or A Level) and when you have/will be sitting for the examinations
- c) Submit the following documents with your application:
 - i. Certified copy(ies) of your International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) certificate(s) – often referred to as GCE Ordinary Level (O-Level) Examinations certificate
 - ii. Certified copy(ies) of your GCE AS Examinations certificate(s), with official transcript to follow – see d) below
 - iii. Certified copies of your high school transcript from Senior 1 onwards
- d) Arrange for a **certified Statement of Results** of your GCE Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Examinations to be sent **directly** from the Examination Board(s), addressed to “Admissions and Student Recruitment (UTSC), HL104 – 1265 Military Trail, Toronto ON M1C 1A4”.
- e) If you are writing any of the Advanced Level examinations before you join the Green Path Summer Program, you must also arrange for the results to be sent directly from the Examination Boards to Admissions and Student Recruitment (UTSC) – see address above. Of course, the final examinations must be pre-scheduled by the Examination Board(s) to take place before the required date to leave China for the Green Path Summer Program.

2) International Baccalaureate (IB) System

- a) You will be considered on the basis of your IB results only if you are completing the full IB Diploma (the IB Certificate does not serve as a basis of admission)
- b) You may be considered **only** if the final exams for all the subjects are pre-scheduled by the IB Office in your region, to be written before the required date to leave China for the Green Path Summer Program.
- c) Please indicate on your application that you are in the IB System.
- d) Submit the following documents with your application:
 - i. Certified copy of your high school transcript from Senior 1 onwards
 - ii. Predicted Results – results of mock exams predicting your final IB results
- e) Arrange for the final results of your IB exams to be sent **electronically** from the IB Office in your region **directly** to the University of Toronto’s main admission office: “University Admissions and Outreach, 172 St. George Street, Toronto ON M5R 0A3”.
- f) Transfer credits may be given for IB Higher level subjects. For details please refer to our website at: <https://www.utsc.utoronto.ca/admissions/high-school-secondary-curriculum>

3) Advanced Placement (AP)/Standardized Tests (SATs)

- a) Students may submit SAT results in support of their application. SAT Reasoning or Redesigned SAT (including Essay) will be considered. SAT Subject Tests will also be reviewed.
- b) You should indicate the test dates for your SAT Subject test/AP if you have taken them at the time of your application.

- d) SAT and AP scores should be sent to in electronically. The SAT and AP institution code for U of T is 0982.
