FULL PROFESSOR in BIOLOGICAL INORGANIC CHEMISTRY

The Department of Physical & Environmental Sciences at the University of Toronto Scarborough invites applications for a tenured position in the area of bioinorganic chemistry at the rank of *Professor* commencing as soon as **January 1, 2011**, subject to negotiation. The position includes an appointment to U of T's Graduate Department of Chemistry and will have undergraduate and graduate teaching responsibilities in inorganic chemistry. The successful candidate will be expected to undertake an active research program centred at the University of Toronto Scarborough. The successful candidate will already hold a position at the rank of full professor at an internationally recognized university, will have a nationally and internationally recognized research program in the area of biological inorganic chemistry with a strong record of external funding, and will have demonstrated a high level of excellence in teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.
