Campus Safety would like to make the community aware of a suspicious person reported to Campus Safety.

It has been reported that a male has been acting suspicious and harassing members of the UTSC community. If you believe you have been harassed by this individual or if you require supports, please contact Campus Safety's Non-Urgent line at 416-978-2323. The individual has been trespassed.

The male is described as 5'8", brown complexion, late 20s, thin build, short black hair, and moustache. He was seen wearing a black puffer jacket with a patch on left shoulder, a baseball hat turned backward, baggy jeans/pants, and white running shoes.

Campus Safety is asking members of the community to always be aware of their surroundings and be cautious, especially when approached by a stranger. If you are aware of any suspicious activity while on campus, please contact Campus Safety immediately at 416-978-2222.
