On Wednesday January 18th, 2023, at 9:30 p.m. an unknown male entered the Student Centre and approached a female staff member who was working in the area. During the interaction, the male shook the female's hand and then began to caress it, continuing to do so as she pulled away. The unknown male then left stating that he would come back later.

Campus Safety Special Constables were called to the scene, along with the Toronto Police Service and an investigation is underway. Campus Safety is increasing their patrols in the area.

The male is described as: Asian, approximately 50 years old, 5'4"- 5'5", average build, blue medical mask, red cap, plaid jacket, and beige pants. If you see anyone matching this description, please call Campus Safety at 416-978-2222.
